Morning Reading Class

The Morning Reading Class (MRC) is a structured reading activity that aims to expose students to various perspectives on complex topics and help them practice analyzing the concept of point of view. The class includes activities such as improving pronunciation, intonation, blending, speed reading, fluency, shadowing, and vocabulary. By participating in these activities, students can develop crucial skills for reading and language learning, and improve their comprehension and communication abilities.

Small Group Classes

This small group class is designed for students to improve their English language skills in grammar, pronunciation, speaking, and vocabulary. The class aims to help students overcome their fears and doubts about speaking English, enabling them to gain confidence and proficiency in using it as a second language. The class will focus on speaking fluently, expanding vocabulary, understanding grammar, and correcting pronunciation errors with the help of the teacher.

Mandatory Self-Study

In the self-study technique, students manage their own learning outside the classroom and without any supervision. The kids are required and encouraged to do this task so they can reflect on the teachings they learned throughout the day. Since they are performing the self-study independently, this activity also gives students the freedom to select the subjects they wish to learn more about and to learn in the manner they like.

Individual Classes

With the help of our qualified teachers, four target skills are to be taught; Speaking, Listening, Writing, and Reading. During an ESL/Test Courses class, students are engaged in a series of activities and exercises that act as building blocks. Step by step, students apply the four target skills learned in previous classes to the challenges in each new session.

Special Class

This class is designed to help students to improve their spoken English skills, with a focus on pronunciation, vocabulary, conversation skills, fluency, and confidence building. In this class, each month, you can expect to participate in various activities that complement your one-on-one learning experience, and you have the freedom to choose your preferred learning approach according to your individual needs. The class takes place in the afternoon at 5:00 pm.

Vocabulary Test

Students must recall and comprehend 20/30/40 words per day from Monday to Thursday by having through the vocabulary test. On the student's first day, the school will give them the required daily materials. Students will have the chance to pick up new vocabulary in this activity, which will also help them grasp it better and apply it to their daily lives.

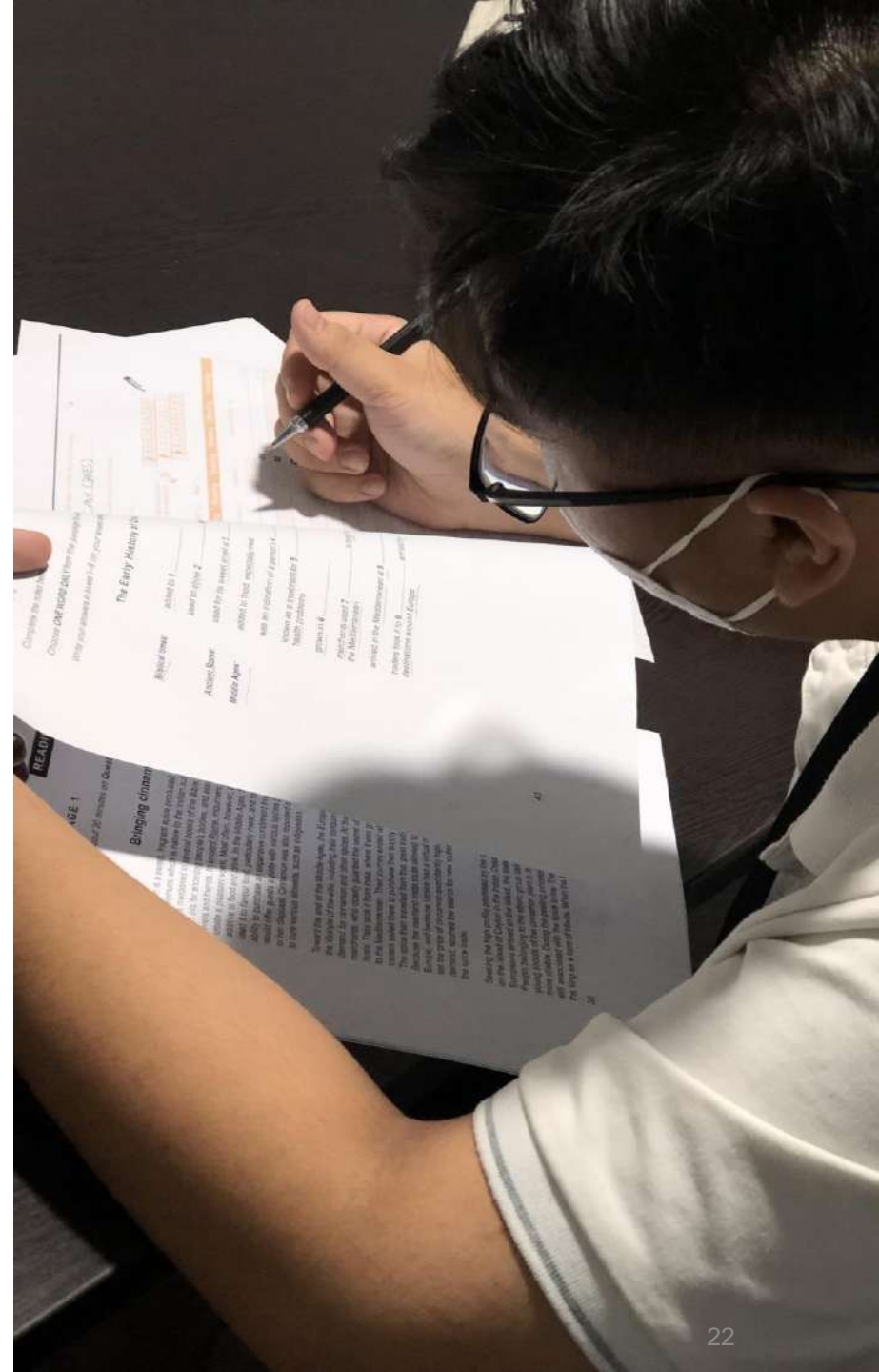

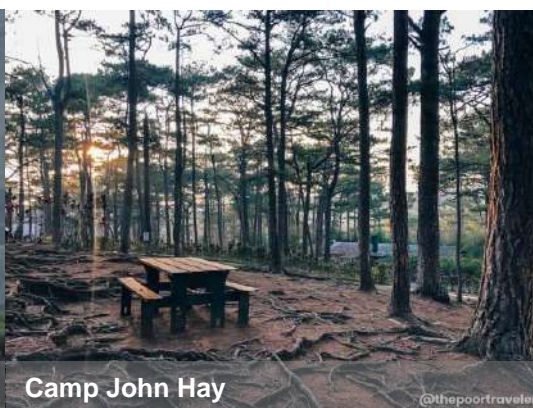

Registration

Cancellation and Refund Policy

1. When the student cancels the study two weeks prior the starting date, tuition fee will be refunded 100% except the enrollment fee 100\$.
2. When the student cancels the study two weeks to 7 days before the starting date, tuition fee will be refunded 50%.
